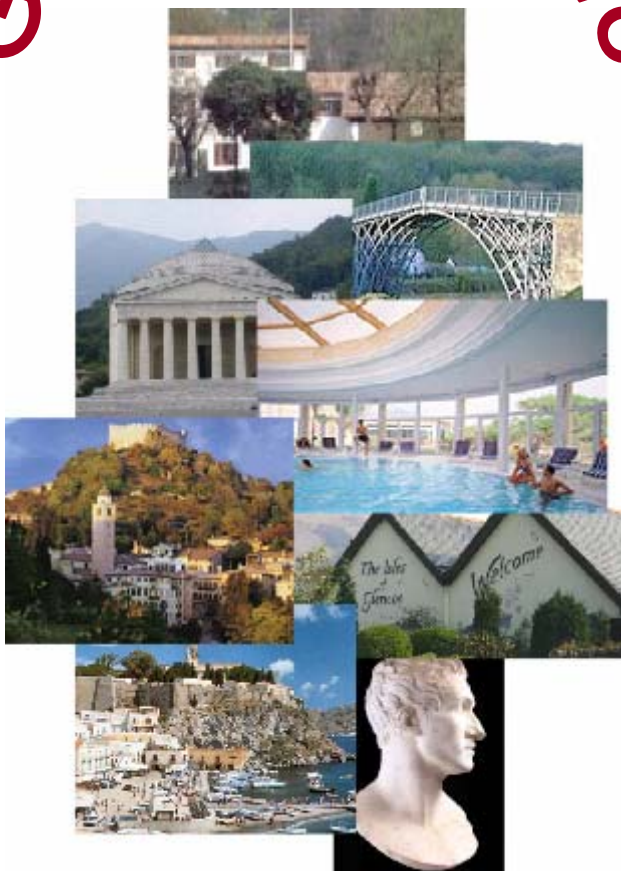

The hotel garden with its swimming pool is so large you could consider it a park.

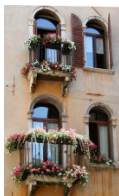
The Location

Abano Terme lies at the foot of the Euganean Hills that provide the source for the waters of the spa and the plethora of hotels in Abano. The Terme Euganei spas are known throughout Europe for their hyper thermal mineral waters .

In the town you will find its bell tower whose lower section dates back to the year 971. Next door to the Cathedral in Piazza del Sole e della Pace is an imposing horizontal sundial that covers an area of 300 square metres.

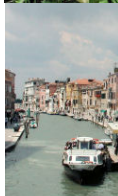
The Veneto

Veneto is one of the twenty Regions of Italy. Located in the northeastern part of the country, bordering the Italian regions of Emilia-Romagna and Lombardy, the autonomic regions of Trentino-South Tyrol and Friuli Venezia Giulia and the republic of Austria. It lies between the Alps and the Adriatic and is traversed by the rivers Po, Adige, Brenta and Piave. The capital is Venice. Other important towns include Verona, Padua, Treviso, Belluno, Rovigo and Vicenza.

You can also go on your own outings; Venice is only a bus ride (€8) away, or take the Burchiello from Padua to Venice - a slow day on a boat cruising down the Brenta Canal visiting villas, taking lunch and finally arriving in Venice from the lagoon, possibly the most romantic way to get there.

Our Hotel

We spend our holiday in **Spoletto** on half board *plus* in the 4 star **Hotel Dei Duchi**. There are 49 elegant bedrooms each with a lovely view: whether over the Ancajani Garden, the Roman Theatre or the wonderful valley. The rooms have been designed and furnished with a view to modern comforts.

The Location

Spoletto boasts a rich historical past which is still faithfully witnessed by the interesting artifacts spread throughout it. The Roman theatre and the old city walls and gates stand next to the visually dazzling cathedral and the majestic Rocca (a 14th century castle), while the entire urban centre has numerous elegant Baroque churches and Renaissance palaces. A tangible heritage of many different civilizations and artistic styles. Cities boasting important works of art, like Assisi, Perugia and Orvieto, are easily reached; Rome or Florence are less than two hours away.

Umbria

In the true heart of Italy, the region is not touched by the sea, and the territory is one-third mountains. Thanks to the temperate climate, the beautiful landscapes and the religious, cultural and artistic wealth of many cities like Assisi, Gubbio, Spoleto, Perugia, tourism is the paramount activity.

Our Holiday

This is our traditional holiday in Italy. This is the 15th edition! You can expect a pleasant atmosphere, good company and some gentle educational activities including, Italian conversation, literature, philosophy, art criticism and music as well as our usual entertainment.

Whilst multinational travel companies can point you in the direction you may want to take, they work from knowledge found on databases and distributed by large travel businesses.

We are different in that we benefit from a constant flow of up-to-date information sent to us from all parts of Italy. If you ask us we may well know somewhere (first hand) that will please you. If we do not, we will know where best to look and how to find you just exactly what you want. Consult us with your ideas and we will see if we can help you activate them.

The British public often think that Italy is expensive. Good hotels often are charging prices similar to those experienced in the UK. However, don't let this view put you off going to Italy which is one of the world's most interesting destinations. Using the cut price airlines, you can now enjoy an excellent holiday in Italy for a modest price.

Agriturismo establishments can be found all over Italy and many have accommodation that is as good as or better than that found in your average hotel. It is also possible to find lower grade hotels that are cheap and cheerful. Whilst the standard of accommodation in these places is not luxurious it is acceptable to most of us when the purpose of our journey is to visit and enjoy the location. Another option for families is self-catering accommodation.

Some suggestions follow which cover many of the regions of Italy.

MUSSOLENTE in the Veneto

The Albergo Volpara, a very small hotel with a very large restaurant presided over by Jimmy, is where you will spend your holiday. The environment is quite serene; not luxurious just relaxed. To use a cliché, this really is far from the madding crowd.



The main attraction of this holiday is Jimmy's cookery course. You will learn about some of the culinary secrets of Veneto, in particular, and Italy in general. You'll learn about bruschetta, crostini, torte vedura, tortellini, tagliatelli, orechiette, pasta sauces and some of the other delights known to Jimmy.



Outings can also be arranged to include Canova's temple and museum, a trip along the Brenta Canal visiting three of the most important Villas: also available are outings to Venice, Padua or Vincenza.

TRASIMENO in Umbria

The Agriturismo “Cantico del Natur” is a farm which has been developed to provide accommodation for tourists. The apartment rooms can accommodate 19 guests and you can stay there either on half board or just for bed and breakfast. The farm is entirely organic and uses traditional harvesting and processing methods recovering flavours from the past.



Located amid the green Umbrian hills with a splendid view of Lake Trasimeno, at an elevation of 450 metres. Just 5 km from the Autostrada, the farm is easily reached and is located in a strategic position for visiting central Italy

PESCHICI in the Gargano

You will stay in the four star **D’Amato Hotel**.

This is the only beach hotel we recommend because of its unique position. It’s built in Mediterranean style and there are 99 rooms, comfortable and well furnished with air conditioning, telephone, tv, mini-bar, safe, toilet with shower and hairdryer. In the restaurant you can taste typical traditional Italian cookery.



The vast majority of the Gargano region is a huge National Park with Monte Calvo at 3465 feet being its highest point. The rich soil hosts almost all the varieties of orchid found elsewhere in Europe as well as several unique to itself. Almost 70 species have been recorded from the region.

CASALE SUL SILE (TREVISO) in the Veneto

You will be staying in the Agriturismo “**Porca Loca**” this a farm which has been developed to provide accommodation for tourists. Patrizia, the ebullient hostess and her husband, who is an excellent chef, have built up a catering enterprise which at weekends provides banquets for up to a hundred people. She has agreed to provide short cookery courses for any small group (up to 12 people).



The accommodation is ensuite, not four star, but the welcome, well that is something different; it has to be experienced to be believed.



*Porca Loca means “Silly Goose” in Italian.
It is a phrase used in place of swearing.*

PORTICO DI ROMAGNA (Forlì) (Emilia Romagna)

The Academy Olmo and the Albergo al Vecchio a great destination for a small group from a club or a group of friends. It's located at the foot of the Apennines but with access to Bologna, Ravenna and Florence. Should you decide to come here for a week, the Carmeli brothers have provided you with more than enough to do in this enchanting place. Their academy offers a number of different courses.



Their hotel's cuisine has made a name for itself and justifiably so. Karen Brown, an internationally renowned American writer of guides to unique places has given the Vecchio Convento an excellent listing. Danish newspapers have complimented it enough to ensure a constant stream of visitors from Denmark. You can be guaranteed something special if you choose to come here.

REGGIO CALABRIA in Calabria



The Grand Hotel de Ville in Villa San Giovanni is located within walking distance of the town centre shops and the commercial centre.

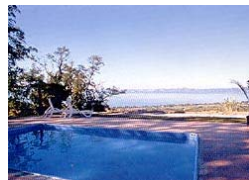
Its renowned restaurant the *Terrasse Mediterranee*, with varied, tasty regional cuisine has a superb panoramic view over the Sicily channel particularly at night.



Close to and run by the hotel is their Cookery School for organised groups which was very much enjoyed by our group (seen here) the last time we visited.

BOLSENA in Umbria

The Agriturismo Belvedere where you will be staying is a farm situated in the hills above the Lake of Bolsena and it is the ideal place for holidays and weekends in every season. It offers twelve comfortable rooms with private bath and central heating; guests can enjoy a friendly, familiar atmosphere and taste typical local homemade dishes prepared in their own kitchen.



It is excellently situated for visiting Etruscan and Roman archeological sites and making excursions to the natural parks around the lake.

LIPARI (Aeolian Islands)

We stay half board in the 4 star **Arciduca Hotel**. The hotel is family run and is not part of a chain.

The rooms are comfortable and flexible, most with balconies. Views from the rooms are not exciting but the roof terrace gives you panoramic views in every direction. There is also a fine swimming pool.

The hotel is set in the urban part of Lipari, an attractive town, which is typically Italian with an important museum and an internationally known archaeological site. A five minute walk from the hotel takes you to the main street and you can if you so wish pass by a frescoed piazza. Another short walk takes you to the tiny old harbour reminiscent of Cornwall although the weather is considerably better.

The old harbour and the promontory is capped by the cathedral. Beneath the cathedral is the Greek theatre, added in the last century, and today used for concerts and presentations.

Despite being a tourist Mecca, Lipari is a place where you will be able to live for a while almost as a native as tourism does not seem to have soured the local people. Only the taxi drivers need watching. It's easy to walk. You do not really need them!

Lipari is the largest of the Aeolian islands. The island's history reflects that of Sicily itself with signs of habitation dating back to primeval times; Greeks, Romans, Normans, Arabs, and Spaniards in succession since. You can see some evidence of all this in the castle, the cathedral and the archaeological park.



UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE

During its 24th Session held in Cairns, Australia, from 27th November to 27th December 2000, UNESCO listed the Aeolian Islands as a unique World Heritage site. The volcanic landforms here represent classic features in the continuing study of volcanology worldwide.

The Hotel

We stay, half board, in the 3 star **Valley Hotel** in Ironbridge, Telford, Shropshire. This fine Georgian listed hotel has recently been sympathetically re-furnished and is a member of the Best Western chain.

Located in fine countryside you are scarcely less than five minutes from the M54. Wherever you are in the country, you will find it relatively easy to reach this destination.



The hotel has 35 individually designed en-suite bedrooms. All have direct dial telephone with data-ports, tea and coffee making facilities, TV, trouser press and hairdryers. Some rooms have views of the River Severn whilst others look over parkland. *There is no hotel lift*

The Location

The Ironbridge Gorge is known throughout the world as the birthplace of the Industrial Revolution. Nowadays the area is far from industrial.

Although the revolution started here, most of the factories are long gone and the natural beauty of the Gorge has been restored. Nature has reclaimed most of the former industrial sites and the gorge is now a maze of footpaths, bridleways and country lanes.

Ironbridge, home to the world's first iron bridge is a World Heritage Site, comprising nine museums dedicated to the history of the Industrial Revolution.

The museums are all within walking distance or just a short drive away from the hotel.

Activities

All the bedrooms have en suite facilities and offer remote control colour television, direct-dial telephone, radio, alarm clock, hairdryers and a complimentary tea and coffee tray. A lift is installed for the comfort of our guests and specially adapted bedrooms for the disabled are available

The Location

Criccieth must surely enjoy one of the most beautiful locations to be found anywhere. Situated on the coast at the edge of the Snowdonia National Park there is something to do for everybody.

Criccieth Castle dominates the town atop its rocky perch and is a must for all visitors, there is an exhibition at the foot of the castle and the short climb to the castle itself rewards you with fantastic views of the Town with the mountains of Snowdonia beyond and to the south a view of the coastline making its way towards the mountain ranges of mid Wales. Also, within easy reach are Portmeirion and the historic castles of Harlech and Caernarfon.

Portmeirion is a fascinating village created by the architect Clough Williams-Ellis in an Italianate style. Full of weird and wonderful buildings salvaged from all parts of the World Portmeirion offers a most fascinating day out. Many of you will remember the village which was used as the set for the TV series 'The Prisoner'

The infamous massacre of 1692 took place at many sites throughout the glen.

Geologically, the Glencoe hills are significant as an example of a volcano collapsing in on itself during a series of violent eruptions. This is also an area of international botanical importance, particularly for the woodlands and arctic alpine flora.

The Holiday

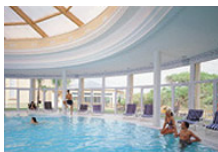

The Hotel

We stay in the 4 star Barrosa Park Hotel in Novo Sancti Petri, Chiclana de la Frontera, Cadiz. This low rise hotel is built among pine trees and located on the edge of a wonderful sandy beach.

There is a good allocation of rooms available with no single supplement. We have our own seating areas within the restaurant, and our own Common Room with free coffee and tea. The Common Room also houses a library for you to borrow books without charge.



The hotel offers exceptionally good food and well appointed en-suite rooms including balconies. There is a heated indoor pool, Gym, Jacuzzi, plus a good range of meeting rooms. Also close by is a splendid 36 hole Golf complex.
